The "Train of taste" is leaving



The "Train of Taste", within an international collaboration, precedes the "Festival of Taste" which will be organized in December in the valleys along the stream Avisio and will involve all its supporting partners, from the tourism authorities to the local producer.

Soft mobility, high-mountain agriculture protecting the biodiversities and gastronomy increasing the value of local products meet on the virtual rail of the "Train of Taste". Transdolomites, an association which fights to realize a train line in the valleys along the Avisio, together with the tourist boards including Fassa, Bolzano, Brescia and Switzerland will explain today at 9.00 a.m. at the Science Museum of Trento through several case studies. The train will be presented at Expo 2015 in Milan as Transdolomites is part of the "International Committee European Heritage Cultural Routes" and it links the communities with the territories, gathering several food and cultural summer events along its rails, including those of Fassa.

Easy walks

From Moena to Medil, Prà Compert and Penia

Reached the southern part of the football field C. Benatti of Moena, take the dirt road that leads to Medil. Ascend crossing the grassy area Val, going out from the wood into Medil hamlet. Pass the centre and nearby the Church continue to ascend along a cobbled road (no.517). Continue to Col de Moena. At the crossroads, take the easy path rightwards. Pass a ramp getting outwards onto the clearing Prà Compert. Border on the wood, and when you reach a stone with white and red sign, walk to the opposite side of the clearing. From here, descend a slope equipped with steps. Shortly the descent becomes easier and reaches the ancient hamlet of Penia. To go back to Moena, cross woods and meadows, leave the forest road, reach the hamlet of Sorte, and finally Moena.

"Pilgrimage of Peace": from Val di Fassa to Rovereto

From Rifugio Contrin, through twenty-one stopovers including those at Rifugio Taramelli and at San Pellegrino Pass, to the Bell for the Fallen in Rovereto. This is the "Pilgrimage of Peace" moving today from Val di Fassa, along the "Peace Pathway", on the Western Front and around the iconic places of the Great War. A path on the memory track, to reach the Bell for the Fallen in Rovereto, emblem of Peace around the whole world. Several local groups, such as ANA, SAT and boy scouts contribute to light up the track, open to those wanting to join, even for only a short segment. On the 20th of July, at the end of the itinerary, a concert of the Ensemble Orchestral Contemporain, conducted by Daniel Kawka, will take place on the hill of Miravalle and transmitted at 9.00 p.m. by Rai Radio 3.

Did you know that...

In the 19th century, especially English and German travellers and the scientists began to choose the Dolomites as their Grand Tour destination. They felt the necessity to tell their experience amongst the marvellous rocks of the territory they were about to discover. Also the naturalist Manchester Churchill, together with his friend Gilbert and their wives, travelled to Carinzia, Tyrol, Carnia and Friuli, between 1861 and 1862. Once he got back to London, he wrote and published "The Dolomite Mountains" in 1864, a precious statement and a masterpiece of touristic promotion of the time.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.

9:00 pm. Piazza de Comun. One of most renowned folk-groups of Fassa valley, found in Campitello in the second postwar period. The group's name means "man beating soles" and is indicative of the peculiar kind of dance performed by its components (all men).

9:00 pm - Piazz Marconi. The mascot of "The anter i Tobie" (starting on Friday) will be the protagonist of the weekly programme's presentation.
