"Fassa Fuori Menu"'s launch in Canazei



The four phases of the festival of the Ladin cuisine are organised by Apt Val di Fassa with the official technical partner Electrolux Professional and in collaboration with the Events committee from Canazei, Vigo and Sità. Find the dedicated brochure by the tourist offices.

"Fassa Fuori Menu" opens today at 5.00 p.m. in Piazz Marconi square in Canazei, with an extraordinary show cooking. This original food festival, with four events during summer, calls ten chef of the valley, captained by the Michelin starred-chefs Paolo Donei and Stefano Ghetta, out of their beloved kitchens to prepare their delicacies in the Old Town, but also in the woods, the grazing and "into the waves". Traditional Ladin foodstuffs and flavours will be reinterpreted by these wizards of cooking and served for an appetizing open air tasting (€ 10.00). The recipes are paired with glasses of Trento Doc (€ 3,50). The inauguration also opens "Te Anter I Tobie", festival of the Ladin traditions from the 4th to the 6th of July in Canazei.

Easy walks

From Vigo to Santa Giuliana

From the chemist's of Vigo, on the left, go up along Strada de Piz street towards the covered fountain and there proceed straight on Strada de Sent'Uiana street. Walk up on the small paved road which leads to the surrounding wall of Santa Giuliana's Church, one of the richest in history buildings of Val di Fassa, whose existence is proved by tokens since 1237. Nearby the Church you can visit the Austro-Hungarian military cemetery, hosting 663 fallen of the First World War from the wide territory of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. On the high ground behind the Church, following the dirt road you will cross the path n. 547, which descends from Vael. Walk down along the road and take Strada de Pontac street and then Strada Rezia street which, turning left, leads to the starting point.

Let's draw the ants!

Pencils, colours, much fantasy and a great teacher. These are the ingredients for an unforgettable afternoon for children, together with Fabio Vettori, the creator of the famous ants, protagonists of his cartoons, posters, t-shirts, diaries, notebooks, puzzles, books and so on. Today at 5.00 p.m. by the gardens in Strada Löwi street in Moena, take part to an amusing workshop to learn how to draw the ants, thanks to the secret tricks of Vettori, who was born in Trento in 1957 but for whom Val di Fassa is now like home. Since the seventies, this funny insects have become Vettori's muses and source of success. To take part to this activity (against payment), it is necessary to enrol by "Le Formiche" shop in Strada Löwi street. (In case of bad weather the activity will take place by the theatre Teatro Navalge).

Did you know that...

In the past in Val di Fassa, after a boy and a girl's official engagement, the priest would read out the banns for three weeks during Mass. Then the spouses could start preparing the events. First of all there was the confection of the "guants a la fascèna", the traditional festive suits, and the invitations and the "segnes da noza", typical festive sweets such as "grostoi" and "grafons" were brought to relatives and godparents. This tradition still remains in the valley. Everything used to happen in winter, as weddings were often celebrated during Carnival, when people weren't working in the fields.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
