"Guerra maledetta e bestia" on stage



The picture "Lettere dal fronte", by Francesco Rizzi from Campitello, one of the "Kriegsmaler", war painters to whom an exhibition is dedicated by the "Ciasa de noscia jent", until the 4th of September, timetable: 4.00 p.m. – 6.30 p.m. and 8.30 p.m. – 10.00 p.m.

The theatre Navalge in Moena hosts tonight at 9.00 p.m. the premiere of "Uh sta Guerra maledetta e bestia" (This damned and savage War) by Fabio Chiocchetti, director of Fassa Ladin Institute, house producer of the show. On stage: pictures, sounds and memories of young men from Fassa who, between 1914 and 1918, were torn off their houses and sent thousands kilometers away to Galicia and Volhynia. On the eastern front of the Great War, they had to face horrors like Death and imprisonment. As counter melody, the "Piccolo Diario di Caterina", through the voice of a twelve-year-old girl, tells the torment of those who remained in the valley. The performance is committed to "Amisc del Teater" from Moena and the music to "Ensemble Neuma", directed by Gianfranco Grisi.

Amazing hikes

In the wild Valsorda

Every logger of Fassa knows this valley. The wonderful and wild Valsorda, which brings to the Latemar, stores along the namesake stream the tracks of the old "cava de le bore" (cave of trunks), a passage for logs and woods five km long, built with stones and rocks, attentively studied, from its slopes to its bends. In winter the frozen cave used to become a sleigh slope where, until the Seventies, thousands of cubic metres of wood passed by. To discover this itinerary, start from Forno di Moena, following path n. 516, which starts from the entrance of the cave, which will be crossed in many spots. Arrived at Valsorda dairy (1676 m - 2 hrs), expert hikers can go on towards Bivouac Latemar (2365 m - 1 h), whereas the less trained can walk along path n. 517 leading to Medil, thence to Forno or to Medil.

Passepartout

The sun, clock of Nature

Everyday it rises and sets, punctuating the rhythms of greenery, animals and men. The sun, life-giving star, has always been a mean to understand the time, for those who are able to read its position in the sky during the day. It works even better if you have an ancient clock: a meridian. We will learn how to build one, today at 5.00 p.m. by the playground in Vigo di Fassa (in case of rain in the meeting room of the Town Council), during "Il paese delle stelle" (The town of the stars), astronomy workshop for families (children from 8 years), organized by the experts of Atlantis from Trento. The meridian, commonly painted on the façades of churches and houses, has very ancient origins and we find its tracks already in the Scriptures. This tool measures the daily light, from dawn to sunset, divided in twelve hours.

Did you know that...

Amongst the protected areas of Trentino there is also the biotope of Roncon, in the municipality of Vigo di Fassa at 1720 m. This is a small peat bog (spreading for around ½ hectare in surface) that lays on a small saddle, in an environmental context which is really striking. A pile of sphagnum - that is peat moss, typical of humid areas - characterizes the peat bog, which hosts rare vegetable organisms. This biotope represents one of the few humid areas in Val di Fassa and it is very important for the local amphibious, as it is a perfect place for breeding.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
