"A Spas co la Musega" hit the marks in Pozza



Strada de Meida street, where "A Spas co la Musega" takes place, is now the centre of Pozza. It starts after the bridge over the Avisio, from Strada delle Dolomiti street and ends at the beginning of Val San Nicolò. Along the street we meet the Town Hall, shops and squares.

The right event for music lovers is tonight in Pozza at 9.00 p.m. Once again, the appreciated appointment with "A Spas co la Musega" (strolling on music) transforms the central Strada de Meida street (closed to traffic) in a party hall. The local music band starts playing contagiously merry tracks, spreading liveliness to folk groups and bands that play ballroom music and the hits of the moment. Music will be integrated by games and baby dance for children, artists and craftsmen at work and even by the motocross exhibition by the local association "Rode a motor" (motor wheels). Do not miss the possibility to taste our traditional delicacies, like the "fortae" (greedy fried sweetnesses), the Apfelstrudel and other savoury and sweet specialities.

Easy walks

From Campitello to Pian

From Piaze de Ciampedel, at the crossroads between Strèda de Salin street and Strèda Senc Felip e Giacum street, we find on our right the steps of the old chairlift station to Col Rodella. Ascend on a pathway which is characterized by the presence of the small Churches of the Via Crucis, until the hamlet called Pian. You can visit the small village, one of the oldest housing clusters of the valley, where there are still some ancient oven for bread. To go back to Campitello, descend the paved street leading to the street Strèda de Col, and then at the starting point. Alternatively, in the opposite direction you can make for the road to Val Duron. After one kilometer, you reach the street that ascends to Campitello. On the left, pass the bridge of Pian da Molin and continue to Campitello, first on flat than particularly steep.

Reading in the wood

Dedicated to children but also to mums and dads, "Libri e letture nel bosco" (Books and readings in the wood). The initiative, promoted today at 10.00 a.m. by the library of Canazei, programmes a walk (start from the library, children must be accompanied) in the woods around the village, with Lia Chiogna who, during several breaks, reads pieces of children's books. Lia Chiogna lives in Trento, surrounded by books. She loves Ireland, the green, Geography, travels, ducks and kites. For more than 20 years she has been meeting pirates, phantoms, witches, fairies, princesses and others fantastic characters from children's book. What makes her happy at most is meeting the astonished eyes of the young readers-listeners she meets at the library or in the open air when she reads them these stories.

Did you know that...

On the 16th February Val di Fassa celebrates its patron saint, Santa Giuliana. In the past, after a very long procession, the people of the valley used to meet in Vigo. The procession was built up by two branches, one departing from Soraga and the other from Penia. The branches got large and large passing through the villages and once in Vigo people began to ascend towards the hill, where the patron's Church is located, and only few people could enter. The majority of people had to pray outside, on the "Cjaslir", worship area already before Christianity in Val di Fassa.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
