Six legends for a path



"Gli stregoni dei Mugoni", "Il lago d'Antermoia", "Re Laurino e la leggenda delle rose", "Gordo e Vinella", "L'enosadira" and "La sorgente dell'oblio" are the stories narrated along the track, collected in an illustrated book for children, by the Ladin Museum.

Places often have a story. But only the most beautiful have a legend. And there is a place on the chain of Catinaccio that has even six of them, that can be learned "Dò I troi de la conties – Along the legends' path". The route, from Ciampedie over Vigo and Pian Pecei at Gardeccia, is suitable for children and families and, tomorrow morning, can be covered with the experts of the Ladin Museum of Fassa. On the track, easy and panoramic, six breaks are planned for the narration of some famous Ladin legends, starting with those about the legendary King Laurin. The activity is against payment and booking is compulsory (€ 3 per person, lifts excluded) at the Ladin Museum (tel. 0039 0462 760182) in San Giovanni, also meeting point at 8.45 a.m. to start the tour.

High-level walks

From Pordoi pass, to Piz and to Boè refuge

From Pordoi pass (m 2.239) ascend by cable car to Sass Pordoi (m 2.950), descending then on small rocks to the near namesake saddle (0.20 h). Go on straight and take path n. 638 that leads to the base of Piz Boè. Climb again, along the southern face, on terraces and detritus ledges, reaching the peak beside Capanna Piz Fassa at 3.125 metres (1.15 h; 1.35 hrs). After a break to enjoy the panorama that surrounds you, descend along the north-western face, pass over it through a ledge equipped with a rope, a rocky jump to reach quickly Boè refuge at 2.871 meters (0.30 h; 2.10 hrs). Come back to Pordoi saddle (0.45 h; 2.50 hrs), crossing the terraces that mark the base of Piz Boè. Go back to the cable car, ascending again to Sass Pordoi (0.20 h; 3.10 hrs).

Weaving charity invisible threads

In these places, youths acquire the basic values for their life: strain, gift, coherence between words and life, team spirit, respect and collaboration towards the others, sensitiveness and attention to the problems of the poorest.

Did you know that...

In 1894 on Sella Pass, a hotel-hospice opened, for pilgrims and climbers, The owner was Carlo Valentini, and his name was given to the refuge, that is near the pass, on the face over Fassa, along the path that led to Gardena Valley. The structure, that had a dining room and 25 beds spread in 16 rooms, during the first days after its inauguration was photographed by Franz Dantone Pascalini, from Canazei. The refuge had been built also thanks to 400 florins lent by SAT, as long as the yellow and blue flag and the emblem of Società Alpinisti Tridentini would have been exposed.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
