### 200 mushrooms exposed..for two days



The exhibit is looked after by Gruppo Micologico Scopoli from Cavalese, under the scientific direction of professor Carlo Papetti. The experts will be there during the exhibit to answer the questions about the mushrooms in the Dolomites, included tasty boletus (in the picture).

In such a rich in underwood treasures season, passionate researchers (but not only) cannot miss, in the rooms of the elementary schools in Piaz J.B.Massar in Vigo, the important mycological exhibit "I funghi delle Dolomiti", that today is at its second and last opening day (10.00 a.m. - 12.00 p.m. and 4.00 p.m. - 7.00 p.m.). Indeed, this works by nature on exposition, such as boletus, chanterelles, parasol mushrooms, honey fungus and others have just been collected, but their freshness doesn't last very much. The exhibit, organized by Circolo Scopoli, is now a usual appointment that let us learn about the characteristics and the edibility of even 200 mushroom families and species, that represent the rich mycological assets of Fiemme and Fassa.

## Did you know that...

In the past Ladin people needed many territories to pasture the cattle. That's why they used to ascend at altitude to reach the passes that marked the border with the valleys. But the passes have never been a real borderline, but rather a meeting point. In fact it is not by chance that it is said that "Pian de jiadoi" ("Players' plain", in Ladin), in the past, was a meeting point to play for the shepherds from Fassa and Gardena, as a witness of the good relationship between people from the two sides of "Jouf de Ciavazes" or Passo Sella.
