### "Shamanes" in concert at Ciampac



"Shamanes Carlos Santana Tribute Band" has been performing for some years and taken part to several music festival around Trentino, and not only, dedicated to Jazz and Rock. In case of bad weather, the show will take place at 5.00 p.m. at "Dolaondes" in Canazei.

The today's concert at 2.00 p.m. on the meadows of Ciampac over Alba di Canazei is dedicated to Carlos Santana and to the 40 years since his album "Lotus". To honour one of the most famous guitarists of the history of music, there is "Shamanes Carlos Santana Tribute Band" from Bolzano, composed by Bruno Festini (voice), Michele Ometto (guitar), Roberto Gorgazzini (keyboards), Maurizio Conta (bass guitar), Sandro Giudici (drums), Jesus Alvarez (percussions and voice), Ray El Molinero (percussions and voice) and Ivo Cestari (percussions). The band celebrates the guitarist, born in Messico in 1947 and able to melt the Latin rhythms with jazz and fusion, with tracks like "Samba pa ti" and "Europa", and tracks from the LP "Abraxas", such as "Black magic woman".

## Easy walks

### From Vigo to Santa Giuliana

From the chemists' s in Vigo, on the left, go up along Strada de Piz street towards the covered fountain and there proceed straight on Strada de Sent'Uiana street. Walk up on the small paved road which leads to the surrounding wall of Santa Giuliana's Church, one of the richest in history buildings of Val di Fassa, whose existence is proved by tokens since 1237. Nearby the Church you can visit the Austro-Hungarian military cemetery, hosting 663 fallen of the First World War from the wide territory of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. On the high ground behind the Church, following the dirt road you will cross the path n. 547, which descends from Vael. Walk down along the road and take Strada de Pontac street and then Strada Rezia street which, turning left, leads to the starting point.

## Passepartout

### On the marmots' path

With their singular whistle they cry havoc in case of "extraneous presences" and after having inspected for some seconds the enemy's advance they hide quickly into their nests. Marmots are nice and hard-coated animals that populate several areas at altitude along Val di Fassa. To learn how to know them better you can take part to "Il sentiero delle marmotte", a walk in the hollow of Ciampac over Alba, tomorrow from 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. Local guides will accompany you along an excursion that allows to learn the characteristics of the animals and the environment of the Dolomites where they live. Booking at the tourist offices within today at 6.00 p.m. (the activity is free, while the lifts ticket is on charge of the participants; possibility to have lunch at the refuge).

## Did you know that...

Each mountain in Fassa is covered by around 20 million woods from the bottom of the valley to 2300 metres, as an interstice among villages, pastures and the rock. The woody belt continues to expand, upward and downward. From the sixties to nowadays, the wood has conquered 500 hectares more. This phenomenon is still evident, made easier by the summer temperature raising that facilitates the wood growth on the hills. The spruce fir is advancing and constitutes the 80% of the total wooden bulk, followed by the larch (15%), the Swiss pine (3%) and the Scots pine (2%).

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
