Discovering "L'uomo e le Dolomiti"

Create your own interpretation of "L'uomo e le Dolomiti". This was asked to the sculptors and to the old boys of "Istituto d'Arte Giuseppe Soraperra" in Pozza that take part, from today to Sunday, to the second edition (the first took place in 2012) of the Sculpture Symposium dedicated to Toni Gross, esteemed artist and mountaineer, teacher at the local school. This dozen of sculptors dispose of a Swiss pine trunk 180 cm long to cut, carve and polish in the open air, in the centre of the village. The works, whose creation can be followed by everybody (and everybody can vote for his favourite), will be then evaluated by a commission headed by the journalist Piero Badaloni, friend of Gross and by the experts Claus Soraperra, Martino Lorenz, Georgia Lucchi and Angelo Orlandi.

Easy walks

From Pozza town-centre to Bagni

This easy walk to the locality of Bagni starts from the picturesque San Nicolò's Church in Pozza: leave Strada de Meida street and take Strada de Freina street on your left, which soon becomes a dirt road and forks after a while. Here take the path that goes down to the right into the wood. Here, the track flattens out to the foot/cycle lane which leads from Bagni to the village of Soraga: turn right, skirting the water purification plant and the stream Avisio, until you reach Pozza and the Town Council, that is located in the locality called Meida. Near the Town Council, cross Piazza de Comun square and turn left into "Promenada enlongia Ruf" (Stroll along the river, in Ladin) that skirts the river Avisio, walk through up along the stream "Ruf de Sen Nicolò" (San Nicolò's river), going back to the beautiful San Nicolò's Church.

Passepartout

More than 19.000 visitors at "La Gran Vera"

After less than two months from the inauguration of "1914-1918 'La Gran Vera' - La Grande Guerra: Galizia, Dolomiti", at Theatre Navalge in Moena, the visitors have been more than 19.000. A success that underlines, also thanks to a numerous public, the quality of the exposition, minded by Michele Simonetti and Mauro Caimi and promoted by Comune di Moena, Istituto Culturale Ladino and the association "Sul fronte dei ricordi". The staging, a treasure of documents, pictures, short movies, audio registrations, evidences, military uniforms and many other relics, divided in four sections: "Galizia 1914", "La trincea", "Dolomiti 1915", "Guerra alla guerra". It can be visited (against payment) until Saturday, 13th of September, 10.00 a.m.-12.30 p.m. and 3.00 p.m.-7.00 p.m.; thursday also 9.00 p.m.-11.00 p.m.

Did you know that...

The presence of heroines, princesses and shepherdesses in Ladin legends, makes believe that in the Dolomites there were descents based on matriarchy. The stories tell also about the existence of tribal groups that, at the arrival of more advanced people, sought shelter in higher and inaccessible areas but then mostly extinguished. The survivors took the name of "salvans", men from the forest, and their women "ninfe" or "anguane", as they were often seen along the water flows. These people, expert of the environment but surrounded by mystery, had often key roles in legends.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
