The Supersummer makes the Dolomites' heart beat



Buy the Supersummer Card at the Tourist Offices and at the lift facilities of Val di Fassa. Two formats available till 20/10/2013: the Family Card (80 Euro - 960 units; 140 Euro - 1750 units; Junior 42-70 Euro), the Single Card (60 Euro - 720 units; 100 Euro - 1250 units).

A strengthened network of offers links 3 Provinces (Trento, Bolzano and Belluno), 11 Dolomites' resorts and 90 lift facilities: the Dolomiti Supersummer, the summer version of the Dolomiti Superski, lets you experience lots of thrilling emotions at high altitude. The initiative has been conceived last year in Val di Fassa and in the other surrounding areas of the Dolomites, and launched this summer with the card that entitles its holders to use without limits all the lift facilities subscribing to the offer, to easily reach what mountain lovers, families and children want. There are plenty of activities to undertake in the open air: biking, trekking, wellness, history, gastronomy and much more, all illustrated in the pocket guide (with 100 ideas). Ask for it at the Tourist Offices of the valley.

Hike

From Pozza to Ciancoal meadows and Meida

Get to the bridge on Avisio River, which links Pozza with Meida and walk along the sidewalk that skirts the state road toward Pera. After 200 metres, leave it, always following now Avisio's flow. Continue until the wooden bridge of Piciocaa. Once you have crossed it, you will arrive in front of a chapel recently restored and a large playground for children. Make your way to the lower path towards Meida, and cross a broad grassy plain in Ciancoal. When you arrive at the asphalt road bearing the same name, you begin to ascend. Afterwards turn right in the Street del Piz and enter Meida, where you find the Church of San Nicolò. From here, follow Street de Meida, and you will get back to the departure point.

Did you know that...

During the last centuries Val di Fassa's painters used to move to Bayern, Tyrol and Switzerland and other areas in order to earn some money offering their ability in painting houses as a door-to-door service. Their iconographic repertoire was taken from a vade-mecum and was mass-reproduced. These artists were well known in the Dolomites and in the surrounding regions as well, and used plates to depict decorative elements, subjects of the animal and plant's world, holy figures and miracle workers.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
