The "Bosch Vino Miglia" on the streets of Fassa



The tour organized by a section of Adac (German Automobil-club with more than 16 million of enrolled people) is an occasion for cars' fans to see the parade of vintage cars like Buick standard Six Tourer (1925) Ferrari 330 GT and Maserati Ghibli passing through Fassa.

The passion for vintage cars makes its fans drive along the streets of "Bosch Vino Miglia". The 7-stages prestigious tour (230-300 Km each stage) is organized by Automobil-club Maikammer - Adac from 15th to 22nd June on the famous Streets of Wine in five different European countries, in collaboration with the German city Landau (where the tour starts and arrives). Today (4th stage) the tour passes in Meran and in the South Tyrol Province, and around 80 vintage cars pass in Val di Fassa as well, one of the "top" stage of the trip. The pilots start driving from Brunico, then pass through Corvara and Arabba reaching the Pordoi Pass, and finally get to Canazei for lunch. After the break they set off for Ora, on the Street of Wine, and in the afternoon they reach the finish in

Easy walks

On the path of Agatha Christie

In the twenties Agatha Christie, also called the Queen of Crime, sojourned during her vacation close to Carezza Lake, near Vigo di Fassa: she was enthusiastic about the area. In one of her crime novel ("The Big Four"), she introduced the hints of her vacations in the Dolomites, describing the rocky Latemar Labyrinth, where some outlaws hid. This itinerary starts from the west side of the Lake with path no.11. Following the trail, you will come to a crossroads: both paths lead to the forest mountain hut Mitterleger, where you find the indication for path no.20, which leads to the Labyrinth. Overstep some larches and enter in the landslip that shapes the maze of the Dolomites. Descend towards a hollow where every summer a pond regenerates itself. Here you find several paths to come back to Carezza Lake.

Take flight in the Dolomites

Admire the scenery from above, getting so close to the peaks that you almost touch them. Vale di Fassa makes the dream of feeling light in the sky come true, exploiting the currents like birds. Canazei and Campitello are considered the first class station for free flying, particularly for paragliding and hang-gliding. Many adventurers launch themselves every day from Col Rodella and Belvedere. The thrill of flying in this natural paradise is not only for experts, but also for novices thanks to the two-seater paraglider, that allows you to fly up in the air with instructors from the Icarus Flying Team School in Canazei. Once you take off from the top of Col Rodella, the way down to Campitello will become an unforgettable experience. Jimmy Pacher from Canazei, paragliding multiple world champion, founded the school (Phone: +39 335 6757667).

Did you know that...

Once upon a time the shepherds of Val di Fassa used the "colarines", that is the collars for cattle, rare for sheep, common for cows. On the contrary those for goats - colarines da ciaura - were popular. They were made with carved fir wood with circular shape and they were also called "elbow" or "lyra" collar, 'cause they recalled the musical instrument. Also the cowbells were important, above all because of their sound: they permitted to identify where the grazing cattle was, especially at night or if the weather conditions were bad, as the cattle could get lost.
