### "Te anter i Tobie" the kingdom of handicraft



The rich program of "Te anter i Tobie" is distributed in the Tourist Offices: on Saturday and Sundays itinerant performances of folks groups, painters and sculptors, displays of milking and grass cutting, presentation of books and much more.

"Te anter i Tobie" (Ladin for "Amongst the barns") lets you travel back in time. The seventeenth edition of this event begins today at 9.00 pm in the hearth of Canazei and continues until 7th July. The party puts on the stage the ancient Ladin traditions of Val di Fassa, especially on Saturday and Sunday, days when not only the manual and creative arts, but also the handicraft markets play a key role. Tonight the celebration starts with the parade of several groups through the street of the village (starting point: Belvedere cable car; arrival: Piazz Marconi) and the opening of 26 wooden barns, historical houses and stands that host - on 7th and 8th July - exhibitions, ancient activities, good music, Ladin delicacies and even Fabio Vettori, author of the funniest ants ever.

## Historical routes

### To Val San Nicolò along Street de Rusci

You can start the historical itinerary from Pozza, from where you have to set off for San Nicolò Valley. Leave the car at the car park Saùch and ascend the narrow wood that hides on the left side Street de Rusci. This name comes from the fact that it was Russian prisoners who built it during the Great War. Follow the path, which alternates flat to moderate ascents, until you come across path no. 641 to "Lach de Lauscel" (L. Lake). Turn left, walk on the gangway on Ruf de Sen Nicolò and enter the wood. The descent continues until an alluvial stony ground and the gully "Giaf". Make your way now to the dirt road of the last stretch of Val San Nicolò. Descending to Hut Ciampié (1.826 m) you will reach the asphalt street until the car park Saùch (2,15 hrs.).

### Shooting in Val di Fassa with Mazzacurati

The shooting of the "La regina della neve" (The queen of the snow) - the new film of the Italian director Carlo Mazzacurati, who won in 1994 the Leone d'Argento with the film "Il toro" - begun last 27th June in Trento, and continues now in Val di Fassa. In collaboration with the Val di Fassa Tourist Board, the director selected several locations for the movie, which is produced by Bibi Film of Angelo Barbagallo in a partnership with Rai Cinema and Trentino Film Commission. Fassa's mountains will be once again the backgrounds of a story that is at the same time a comedy and a sentimental film - author's definition. The movie tells about the vicissitudes of a tattooer, role played by Valerio Mastrandrea, and a beautician, performed by Isabella Ragonese.

## Did you know that...

The foundation of the Italian Alpine Club occurred in summer 1863, when Quintio Sella ascended the Monviso with other famous persons. The opening meeting took place at the Castello del Valentino in Torino, on 23rd October 1963. For the event, the 170 members elected the baron Perrone di S.Martino for president. In this way, the Italian Alpine Club was born, and the first quarterly bulletin was published in April 1965. The Palazzo Carignano in Torino became then the official CAI seat, and in 1873 the association gathered 1308 members, subdivided into 12 sections.
