Soft mobility for Moena, the Alpine Pearl



The replay of the event tomorrow: from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. in Piazz de Ramon try of electrical vehicles. In the afternoon there will be the cycling excursion around Moena on the cycle lane, followed by a tasty snack at Prà di Sorte.

The new ways of making tourism are presented on 6th and 7th July in Moena. The village, elected Alpine Pearl in 2011, launches the challenge called "Legs and innovation. Philosophy and technology for a soft and sustainable mobility". The event offers the possibility to try (10 am - 4 pm, Piazz de Sotegrava) the electric vehicles and to take part at the conference "New equilibrium: the touristic offer between sustainability and innovation" at 5 pm in the Municipal Hall. The main participants are: the directors of the Tourist Board of Fassa and Fiemme Andrea Weiss and Bruno Felicetti, the architect Irma Visalli, and the expert of Foreign Languages for Business and Tourism Marika Tiozzo and Martina Palù, moderated by the journalist Silvano Ploner.

ITINERARIO

From Vigo to hamlets Vallongia and Tamion

From the centre of Vigo go towards Costalunga until the bridge on Ruf de Val (a stream): at this point follow Street de Pontac until a crossroads. Walk on the left side and go beyond a turnstile, towards the upstream flow. A path leads you to a hollow, where the fitness track starts. Continue till an equipped area for children. On the opposite side of the clearing, descend leftwards to the forest road of Vael, until it joins the street heading to Vallongia. Now make your way to the hamlet. Walk upward to the Church of San Giovanni Nepomuceno, and turn left when you find the fountain. After crossing Street delle Dolomiti, descend to the valleys Grave, covered with streams, easy to cross if you walk on the right after the crossroads after the second stream. Then ascend to Tamion. You come back doing the same itinerary backwards.

Some people look for the unique product or rather the ancient one, others love rubbernecking among stands until a special object captures their attention. Shopping in open-air markets is one of the funniest activities to do in holiday. You have plenty of time to look around, and purchasing at special prices. Every day Val di Fassa's open-air markets offer a wide choice of products, such as items for home, traditional textiles, antique furniture, wooden crafts, gastronomic local delicacies, technical clothes for summer and winter sports, mountain footwear and much more. The market takes place on Mondays in Campitello, on Wednesdays in Mazzin and Moena (second and forth Wed. of July and August), on Thursdays in Pozza di Fassa, on Fridays in Soraga, on Saturdays in Canazei and on Sundays in Mazzin.

Did you know that...

In the 19th century, especially English and German travellers and the scientists begun to choose the Dolomite as their Grand Tour destination. They feel the necessity to tell their experience amongst the marvellous rocks of the territory they were about to discover. Also the naturalist Manchester Churchill, together with his friend Gilbert and their wives, travelled to Carinzia, Tyrol, Carina and Friuli, between 1861 and 1862. Once he got back to London, he wrote and published "The Dolomite Mountains" in 1864, a precious statement and a masterpiece of touristic promotion of the time.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.

Canazei

The whole day - in the village. Opening of the ancient barns and houses that host artists' performances and activities of yore. Moreover, from 10 am to 12 am, there's the possibility to taste the Ladin traditional delicacies at the numerous stands, while folks group and band are playing and singing.

10 am - 12 pm and 5 - 7 pm - Piazz de Ramon. The particular wooden works realized by the artist are on exhibit in the "Stala de l Janac".

Beyond the mill

10 am - 12 pm and 3 - 7 pm - Pera. The mill "L Molin de Pezol" had 3 hydraulic blades that made the milling machine and the polisher working.
