### "Othello" is onstage at Navalge Theatre



The "Othello" went on stage for the first time at the Teatro della Scala in Milan on 5th February 1987 (image: original poster). You can purchase the ticket for the tonight's performance at the Tourist Office and Alpine Pearl in Moena (cost: 20 euro).

The Navalge Theatre in Moena hosts today at 9.00 p.m. the 4 acts drama "Othello" to celebrate the two hundredth anniversary of Giuseppe Verdi's birth, with the booklet by Arrigo Boito based on William Shakespeare's tragedy. The opera is performed by the Orchestra Filarmonica Italiana, directed by Maestro Alessandro Arigoni. The protagonist of the opera is Othello, general in the Venetian army and Desdemona's husband, who falls into the trap of Jago, a high-ranking soldier. The latter hates Othello for promoting the younger man Michael Cassio above him, and makes him believe that his wife slept with Cassio. Othello, eaten by jealousy smothers Desdemona. However, he rapidly unmasks Jago, and commits suicide after kissing his wife for the last time.

## High-level walks

### From Ciampedè to Coronelle Pass to Gardeccia

The cable car takes you from Vigo up to Ciampedè (1.998 m), where you will take path no.545 until Roda de Vael Refuge (2.283 m; 1,45 h). Continue then on the path no.549, to the southern layers of Majaré. At high altitude make for the western face of Roda de Vael, leading to the Refuge A. Fronza (2.339 m; 1,30 h; 3,15 hrs.). After passing the rock way, at the crossroads turn right towards the rill that leads to Passo Coronelle (2.639 m; 1h; 4,15 hrs.), from where you descend the pebbly path until the Davoi hollow. At the crossroads turn left on path no.541, and passing below the east face of Catinaccio, through an easy path, you reach the route that ascends to Preuss and Vajolet Refuges. The descent to Gardeccia is on the right (1,15 h; 5,30 hrs.); afterwards head to Ciampedè (0,45h; 6,15 hrs.).

## Passepartout

### The "North wind" blows for Alfredo Pauselli

The story of Alfredo Pauselli, pioneer on the Dolomites, is told in a book published by his nephew bearing the uncle's name, presented today at 5.30 p.m. in the square Perla Alpina in Moena. Pauselli was born in Trentino in 1900, spent his youth in Switzerland and Germany, then moved to America, where he could practice athletic. He moved back to Switzerland, where he learnt skiing, and again to Val di Fiemme, where he climbed, opened alpinist routes and worked as alpine guide. In 1934 he became ski teacher and built the refuge Capanna Cervino on Rolle pass, where he founded the 1st ski school on the Dolomites. He inaugurated slopes and lift facilities, and was the protagonist of legendary adventures, also thanks to his most important work: Baita Segantini hut surrounded by the lake where the peaks reflect their shapes.

## Did you know that...

Rumour's been saying for centuries that the cardinal Nicolò Cusano (bishop of Bressanone from 1450 to 1464) consecrated the Church of Santa Giuliana in 1452. Actually, the evidence that Cusano was in Val di Fassa has been proved only recently. In a small chapel under the main altar of the church was brought to light a lead chest containing a parchment with Cusano's seal (a shrimp) together with the relicts - put under the altar during the consecration's moment - of Giuliana, Dorotea, Andrea, Albano, Innocenzo e Ingenuin.
