### Forehand and backhand in the Fairy fields



The Tournament Open (one of the few in Trentino Alto Adige) is organized by the Tennis Club Moena and the players (age starting from 14 years old) come from several areas of Italy. Many tennis players take advantage to make a holiday in Val di Fassa.

Around 80 athletes challenge each other from today until 18th August on the synthetic tennis courts of Navalge Centre in Moena, in order to award the "Trofeo Cassa Rurale Val di Fassa e Agordino". The competition Open (open to all categories of the card-carrying FIT members and valid for "Trentino Coop Prix") is just for single matches for men this year, but offers a richer jackpot compared to the last years' one (when to the matches participated girls too). Up for grabs 3200 euro, two holiday weeks in Moena, weekly ski passes for the Trevalli resort, prizes that are awarded up to the 8th classified in the final rank (the winner gets 1000 euro, 1 holiday and a ski pass). Men belonging to the 2nd category challenge each other, among which some experts too (2.1).

## High-level walks

### From Pordoi to Boè Refuge

Get to Pordoi Pass and take the cableway to Sass Pordoi (2.239m); from there, descend towards the saddle Pordoi (0,20 h). Keep going on and take path no.638, leading to the foot of Piz Boè. Ascend now its southern hillside with steps and rubble ledge, arriving at Capanna Piz Fassa at 3.152 m (1,15h; 1,35 h). Take a break to admire the wonderful landscape at 360°. Descend now on the north-western mountainside, overtake a rocky passage by way of an equipped wire, and you get quickly to Boè Refuge at 2.871 m (0,30h; 2,10 hrs.). Get back to the saddle Pordoi (0,45 h; 2,50 hrs.) crossing the rocky stairways on the foothill of Piz Boè. Return to the cableway heading upstream to Sass Pordoi on a rocky trail (0,20 h; 3,10 hrs.).

### "The four Season" of the Ants

## Did you know that...

Once upon a time, the inhabitants of the hamlets Mazzin, Campestrin and Fontanazzo could reach Val Gardena or Castelrotto through the steep paths of the valleys Val Udai and Val di Dona, in order to trade food and wares. Actually, they did not like these pathways, and preferred to walk along the valley bottom and then ascend the dirt roads departing from Pera and Campitello. Here there were roads more frequented (that means less dangerous) and above all they were not inaccessible as the others if they need to carry heavy wagon with products, food and provender.
