In Moena the footrace...of bats



The "Giro de le Notole" is organized by the U.S. Monti Pallidi. There will be funny free gifts for all the participants at the finishing line (around 22.00 p.m.) in Piazz de Sotegrava. Prize giving to the first three athletes of each category (photo: archive Monti Pallidi).

They gather at dusk, and meet in the square Piazz de Sotegrava at 9.00 p.m., just to challenge each other in a route, which is 6 km long along the street of the village. They are the participant of the "Giro de le Notole" ("Tour of bats", in Ladin), a race that boasts its 38th edition. Athletes kick off, but also amateurs as well, of all ages and above all groups of all origins (well accepted are those composed by the guests of the same hotel). Crossing Moena under the moonlight together with somebody is really amusing. Above the trophies for the seven contending categories (from puppies to veterans), in Piazz de Ramon there is a flying finish line (with prize). Booking (€ 8) at the gazebo in Piazz de Sotegrava (today 10.00 am - 12.30 pm and 4.00 - 8.45 p.m.).

High-level walks

From Gardeccia to Santner Pass

This is a "High-level walk" that kicks off from Gardeccia: you reach it on the easy path no. 540 or with the shuttle service that departs from the car park nearby the "Vajolet 1" chairlift in Pera (approx. from 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.). Walk on the dirt path no. 546 and pass a ledge to enter the beautiful Vajolet Valley. On the left side go upwards to the rill following the signalled turns, take pathway no. 541 and head to the Refuges Vajolet and Preuss (1 h from Gardeccia). Make for path no. 584 and enter the cleft of the towers proceeding cautiously because the rocks are smooth here. You will arrive at the Refuge Re Alberto at 2.621 m (1 h; 2 hrs.), among Torri del Vajolet, Catinaccio and Crode de Re Laurin. Through an easy gully you can go to Passo Santner (0,30 h; 2,30 hrs.).

Did you know that...

Val di Fassa' routes had been for centuries just tree-line roads and paths in the woods: for this reason, the streets and paths of Val di Fassa have always been characterised by the presence of crosses and chapels, often decorated with saints' frescos and moralizing paintings, symbolizing the Sacred shaping people life. Actually, they were in the past a hallmark for pilgrims and travellers, especially when the area lacked of signals for the ones who travelled by foot or rode horses, through forests, crossroads, passes and valleys.

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
