"Omegn da mont" a party in Campitello



In September 1871, the Dieta of Innsbruck filled out the 1st regulation for mountain guides. The guides' name in Val di Fassa were disclosed only in 1875 by the Captaincy of Cavalese: they were Giorgio and Giovanni Bernard, and Giovanni Mazzel, all from Campitello.

The today's party in Campitello is dedicated to the people who love the mountain so much that they decide to spend there their life on it or simply elapse their holiday. "Festa di Omegn da Mont" is a well-established tradition above all for alpine guides and the volunteer of the alpine rescue of Val di Fassa. The event takes place at 9.00 a.m. in the Padiglione Manifestazioni at Ischia, and at 9.30 a.m. the Mass is celebrated and the mountain equipment is blessed. Afterwards, the parade starts heading to the monument of the Guides in Piazz de Ciampedel, and a commemorative ceremony follows. At 11.00 a.m. there will be the band "Musega Auta Fascia" performing on the "Pian da la Teiles", location in front of "Cesa de la Guides", and thereafter everyone is invited to the refreshments.

Amazing hikes

From Moena to Lusia Pass

You can start this "Amazing hike" from Moena: walk upwards the street Strada de Longiarif, cross the state road diagonally, and get onto the forest road: it ascends steeply to La Rezila Refuge (1.760 m; 1,30 h - to be added at the final time). Alternatively, to get there, you can drive from Moena to Ronchi, park at the lower station of Lusia cableway and take the cable car till the second station of Lusia. From here you reach easily Refuge La Rezila, as the footpath is mostly flat (0.20 h - to be added at the final time). When you reach the Refuge you can continue on the dirt road that merges into a grassy cleft at Lusia Pass at 2.055 m (1 h). You will enjoy the 360° beautiful landscape over the group of Pale di San Martino Chain and over the whole valley Val di Fassa. You go back following one of the signed routes.

Sacred songs at Santa Giuliana

In the occasion of the Assumption of Mary in the Church of Santa Giuliana in Vigo, the first performance of "Gioisci, Vergine e Madre" (Matrum Matri), which is a melodies collection by the Maestro Walter Proni. The collection is composed by fourteen pieces for the piano, written in sixty years of career (started at 12 years old), and are interpreted by the soprano Claudia Gravini. The concert gives the possibility to listen to some pieces dedicated to Mary, both ancient and modern, in Italian and in Latin as well. Some of them have already been recorded by 'internationally renowned artists and presented by Pope John Paul 2nd in the Sala Nervi in Vatican for the year of Mary (1988). Proni and Garavini chose Val di Fassa to present these pieces due to the strict link the have with the valley since many years.

Did you know that...

The "mana" is the traditional flower and alpine herbs posy picked on 14th August by the Ladin people on the pastures, and let it bless for the Feast of the Assumption, in Ladin "Sènta Maria Maor". The bunch of flowers, recalling the Mary's fragrance, had to be hanged in the loft, were it blighted, in order to protect home, or it hanged up in the stable to protect the cattle. In case of illness, the animals were nursed with an infusion of "mana". The custom is still in vogue as the candlelight walk for the Assumption of Mary, that take place today in Moena, Pera and Canazei (9.00 pm).

To participate in the initiatives for guests is compulsory to register at least one day in advance at the Tourist Offices of the Val di Fassa Card (ask your employer accommodation). The activities are reserved for guests of the associated structures all'Apt Val di Fassa.
