HIGHLIGHTS

TRUMPET AND PIPE ORGAN AT CIAMPEDIÈ

Baroque sounds trio today at 1 p.m. in the panoramic hollow of Ciampedie easily reachable by cable car from Vigo. For the festival Panorama Music performs the original trio composed by Paolo Trettel, from Val di Fiemme, and Alex Gai & Ai Yoshida. Alex is from Veneto and Ai is Japanese (living in Italy for many years) in 2006, they founded the band "Organ Duo". The couple boasts an intense artistic career as performers with the participation to many important organists' festivals both in Europe and in Japan. Together with Trettel, they perform their repertoire including eighteenth-century music such as Johan Sebastian Bach, but also compositions by Georg Friedrich Händel and Joseph Haydn until the contemporary music by Arutiunian and Gàrdonyi.

Itineraries

FROM MOENA TO THE MOUNT TOÀC

This "High-level walk" starts from the picturesque hamlet of Sorte, over Moena: follow the easy road that leads to Malga Peniola. Before reaching it, take pathway no. 521. The taxing trail passes by the area named Frata and turns towards Coston da Ciamp, arriving at the peak Sas da Ciamp (2.193 m; 2,30 hrs.). Here, from this high and panoramic point, a lot of hiking trails begin: you can go back along the same footpath or expand your hike. Fit hikers can descend from Forcella Peniola first on path no. 524 and then on path no. 517 till Costalunga Pass and thence go back to Moena along path no. 519 (6.30 hrs.). Alternatively, they can walk along the ridge of Toàc pastures, reaching Mount Toàc (2.319 m). Along the footpath no. 517 you can return to Malga Peniola and then to Moena (5,30 hrs.).

Did you know that...

In the nineteenth century, Fassa's agriculture was almost the same as it was in the previous centuries, since it did not experienced great innovation techniques. Many products important to population's nourishment needed to be imported. In Val di Fassa, the highest of Trentino's valleys, the lands suitable for farming were few, therefore the cultivable fields both in the valley bottom and at high altitude grounds (not too steep), were on the right side of Avisio River in order to obtain in that way the widest solar radiation.
