THE THRILL FOR THE OPENING OF THE PRINCIPE IN A VIDEO

On flight, in the heart of the Catinaggio, towards summer at the refuge Passo Principe: the furnishing brought by helicopter, with loads of 800 kilos transported with the winch like big shoppers till in front of the refuge and, above all, the emotions of the owners – the mountain guides Sergio and Daniele Rosi – for the beginning of a new season. All this is narrated in the video “The opening of Rifugio Passo Principe”, published on the social media of Val di Fassa Tourist Board at mid-June, which in only 4 days has been viewed more than 62 000 times and got 1525 likes, 1311 sharing and hundreds of enthusiast comments for the pictures and professionalism of the Rosis. And the video, conceived and realised by the journalists Andrea Selva and Elisa Salvi, has even been published on several online magazines of the group Espresso.

Itineraries

FROM RONCHI TO FANGO

From the overpass of the Lusia ski slope on the state road from Moena to San Pellegrino pass, continue driving for 700 m until the small park area on the right, before the bridge on Rif de Sèn Pelegrin stream. Leave the car and walk straight ahead on the forest road, parallel to the stream. The trail is composed by flat tracks that alternate with few easy ascents and three ramps, which do not exceed 250 m of length. Along the trail you will find a point of sparse trees (where - in the past - an avalanche swept away the wood); leave on your right path n. 625 (leading towards Malga Colvere) and cross the stream in the area of "Fango" nearby a well-equipped picnic area with tables and benches (2 hrs. from the parking). Come back along the same path.

Did you know that...

“A painter between myth and reality”: this show is called Francesco Rizzi (1868 -1952), the painter from Campitello who in 1922 took part in the Biennale di Venezia together with several futurists. But he will soon detach from the avant-guards that do not share his vision of the nature as the expression of an eternal truth. In 1933, while in Oxford, Rizzi has even the chance to realise the portrait of Albert Einstein. He is much appreciated for his paintings of the landscapes of the Dolomites and his most famous work is “Letter from the front” dating back to 1915.
