SCENERY AND MUSIC WITH THE DAKHABRAKHA AT "THE SOUNDS"

They are original, theatrical, cutting-edge. The Ukrainian music band Dakhabrakha (which means "give/take" in ancient Ukrainian) performs today at 12.00 p.m. in Val San Nicolò, by the mountain hut Baita alle Cascate. This group raises much interest, for its being able of creating new sound worlds, taking from the traditional repertoire but re-inventing it, with contemporary influences. The DakhaBrakha, according to the critics, bring together the scene of the avant-garde urban theatre and the life in the villages that feed Ukraine cultural richness, showing the euphoria of the most fascinating part of the East European folklore. The location of the concert can be reached from Pozza to the car park Sauch in Val San Nicolò and then on foot (1 hour walking).

Itineraries

FROM PIAN DE FRATACES TO COL RODELLA

This amazing hike starts in Canazei. Drive (or walk) towards the hotel Lupo Bianco at Pian de Frataces, park your car and leave the street going towards the bridge over Ruf de Antermont stream. Cross it and take path n. 655 that follows Col de Pica forest road. When you reach Ruf de Val stream, go on to the limit of the wood towards the Costa Rossa. Turn right and go up to Pian de Marizanela. You will have to face a steep track to the hollow of Val. Once arrived at a crossroads, go left ascending a wide plain (0,45 h), then cross it and go up entering Val Salei, proceeding towards Passo Sella (not much over Rifugio Valentini; 0,30 h; 1,15 h). From here, go left towards Rifugio Des Alpes (0,45 h; 2,00 hrs): here take the path that in 15 minutes brings to Col Rodella (2.484 m).

Did you know that...

"Tobià" or "tabià", that's how the hayloft is called in Ladin. The most ancient structure was completely in wood but, with the time, it would be integrated with a basement in dry stone. The Tobià, attached but separated from the house, used to host the stable at the lower floor, with the "cianèl, the wooden manger and the foodstuff storage. On the upper floor there was the hayloft, with the "palancins" and the "barcons" (balconies), that would often have give access to the ramp or to the bridge (in stone or dirt), on which the "cèr" or "masaria da fen", the wagon charged with hay, would be pushed with just the strength of the arms.
