"SCINTILLA" LIGHTS UP THE SOIRÉE IN CANAZEI

A soirée dedicated to laughter awaits you tonight from 9.00 p.m. in the square Piaz Marconi in Canazei. On the stage, in the core of the village, Gianluca Fubelli, better known as "Scintilla", one of the most appreciated comedian of "Colorado", the famous Italian TV show. Scintilla brings to Val di Fassa his most famous characters: Omo Ragno, Yoghi Key, Pupo Secchione, a modern Giulio Cesare and the "most handsome men in Italy". The comedian has moved his first steps with the group "I Turbolenti", with whom he successfully takes part in several cabaret festivals, until he arrived in 2002 to "Colorado Caffè", directed by Diego Abatantuono, who in 2012 called him in the cast of the movie "Area Paradiso". Fubelli has taken part in a film in 2014 too, "Tutto molto bello", directed by Paolo Ruffini.

Itineraries

IN VAL SAN NICOLÒ ALONG THE "STRADA DI RUSCI"

This captivating itinerary starts from Pozza: to set off for Val San Nicolò, leave the car at the car park Saùch and ascend along the narrow wood that hides, on the left, the picturesque path "Strada de Rusci", so called because it was built by the Russian prisoners during the first World War. Follow the path, which alternates flat segments to moderate ascents, until you come across path n. 641 to "Lach de Lauscel" (Lagusel Lake). Turn left and cross the stream "Ruf de Sèn Nicolò" walking on the comfortable gangway above it and enter the wood. The path continues descending to an alluvial stony ground and then crossing the bed of the stream "Giaf". Make your way now to the dirt road of the last stretch of Val San Nicolò. Going down to Baita Ciampié (1.826 m) you will reach the paved street to Saùch car park (2,15 h).

Did you know that...

The "toal del Mason", natural line of detachment of landslides and debris accumulation, is located in the area of San Pellegrino. Here, there was a deposit of "blue calcite vesuvianite" that is now extinguished, unfortunately, due to excavations conducted senselessly. In 2000, anyway, some geologist found, also here, a stretch of still intact mineralization and from here several geodes containing crystals up to 30 mm long were extracted. This mineralization has been associated to the "fassaite" variety, a contact mineral that generated from the physical-chemical changes that were caused from the upwelling of magma in limestone.
