IN THE WOOD WITH THE PERMISSION... FOR THE MUSHROOM

Summer is quite generous with those who like picking up mushrooms: the sun, the warm temperatures and the frequent rainfalls have had positive consequences on the growth of this delicacies of our woods. Now, especially, in the favourite month for mushroom-chasers, you just have to venture through paths, musks, bushes and other conifers. But, before hitting the road with your basket, remember to get the necessary permission: you need to report your activity by one of the six municipalities or pay an amount of money that changes according to the duration of the collection (minimum € 10 for one day, maximum € 60 for 1 month), using dedicated payment slips. It is allowed to pick up mushrooms every day during the week (from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.) and to collect up to 2 kilos a day per person.

Itineraries

FROM THE GARDECCIA HOLLOW TO SANTNER PASS

Reach the refuges at Gardeccia from Ciampedie along the comfortable path n. 540 or by shuttle (departing from the car park of chairlift Vajolet1 in Pera, approximately from 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.). Go on along the dirt road n. 546 and, passed the ledge, enter the beautiful Vajolet valley. On the left, ascend the scree through well signalled hairpin turns and then take path n. 541, leading to Preuss and Vajolet refuges (1 h from Gardeccia). Take path n. 584 and enter the cleft of the Towers, proceeding cautiously as the rocks are smooth. Arriving at Re Alberto Refuge at 2.621 m. (1 h – 2 hrs) you will find surrounded by the Torri del Vajolet, Catinaccio and the Crode de Re Laurin. An easy path on the scree brings to Santner Pass refuge (0.30 h – 2.30 hrs).

Did you know that...

In several areas of the valley, for example at Ciampac in Alba, there are several dark rocks. These were underwater lava dating back to more than 230 million years ago. These report an intense activity in the area. The lava, pouring at high temperature by the magma ducts and getting in touch with colder sea water, assumed a globular structure defined "cushion". The outside surface of these "cushions" got cold quicker than the inner layers and, squeezing, it would tend to brake like bread crust, assuming concentric structure and layers.
