NINE CHOIRS FOR THE “EUROPEAN DAY OF THE REFUGES”

The “European day of the refuges”, which is now at its fourth edition, is celebrated today through the mountain chants. The event – organised by the Mountain Academy in collaboration with SAT, Associazione Rifugi del Trentino, Federazione dei Cori del Trentino and Trentino Marketing – is dedicated to the “keeper” of the peaks, the mountain refuges and the people that run them, important reference points for mountaineers and alpinists. So, four out of nine refuges around Trentino involved in the celebrations are located in Val di Fassa. Do not miss the performances, so, of the different choirs: Coro Vanoi from Canal San Bovo is at the refuge Castiglioni-Marmolada, Coro Genzianella from Roncogno is by the refuge Contrin, the Coro Piramidi from Segonzano is at the refuge Fuciade and the Coro Valle dei Laghi from Padergnone is at Gardeccia.

Itineraries

FROM THE REFUGE PAOLINA TO THE RODA DI VAEI

Once reached the Carezza pass (1746 m) from Vigo, go on towards the namesake lake until you see, on your right, a label indicating the chairlift Paolina (and the parking beside it). Take the chairlift that leads, in few minutes, to the 2125 metres of the refuge Paolina. From there, take the path n. 539 that goes straight up along some wide tiers, leading the gaze to the powerful rocks of the Catinaccio on one side and of the Latemar on the other one. After an uphill stretch, go on along a pleasant slight slope, sometimes rocky, until (after about 30 min.) you come across a big bronze eagle, of which you can't avoid taking a picture. It is the monument dedicated to Theodor Christomannos, to whom the construction of the “Great Road of the Dolomites” is due. After about 30 min. walking along the path n. 549, you will reach the refuge Roda di Vael. Go back along the same path.

Did you know that...

During the second half of the nineteenth century, the Ladin language aroused the interest amongst scientists and linguistics who reached the valley and used to ask people from Fassa, usually concentrated on their work in the fields and on looking after the cattle, in order to understand the features of that spoken language. This way, they started to fix the first characteristics of Ladin. Among the most important scholars there was Christian Schneller, Austrian school inspector who in 1870 started off the official studies on the spoken language of the Dolomites, the Anaunia and Friuli.
