“THE DAWN” WITH NERI MARCORÈ, MARIO BRUNELLO AND OTHER ARTISTS

During the 25th edition of the festival “The Sounds of the Dolomites” everything is special, included the show at “Dawn” on July 20th at 2500 metres on Col Margherita (at 6.00 a.m.), which can be reached from San Pellegrino by cable car. The rising sun that illuminates the Dolomites, is part of the rich performance: the project (specifically created) “Meanwhile let’s play” is presented by a large group of actors and musicians, composed by: Neri Marcorè (who has already been at “The Sounds” in Fassa), Marco Rizzi, Regis Bringolf, Danilo Rossi, Mario Brunello, Florian Berner, Gabriele Raggianti, Ivano Battiston, Signum Saxophone Quartet. The artists in Val di Fassa will perform in a show through music tracks and words, a “century-long journey: music against war, humanity against brutality”.

Itineraries

IN VAL SAN NICOLÒ ALONG “STRADA DI RUSCI”

Go from Pozza to Val San Nicolò by shuttle bus, shuttle train or on foot, ascending along the narrow wood that hides, on the left, the picturesque path “Strada de Rusci”, so called because it was built by the Russian prisoners during the first World War. Follow the path, which alternates flat segments to moderate ascents, until you come across path n. 641 to “Lach de Lauscel” (Lagusel Lake). Turn left and cross the stream “Ruf de Sèn Nicolò” walking on the comfortable gangway above it and enter the wood. The path continues descending to an alluvial stony ground and then crossing the bed of the stream “Giaf”. Make your way now to the dirt road of the last stretch of Val San Nicolò. Going down to Baita Ciampié (1.826 m) you will reach the paved street to Saùch car park (2,15 h).

Did you know that...

“Queen of the Dolomites”, the name that is often used to indicate the Marmolada, was “invented” by father Luigi Baroldi, born in 1853 in the Giudicarie area and sent to the Pieve di San Giovanni di Fassa in 1875, minister in Penia between 1879 and 1880. He was a passionate mountaineer and conducted some historic-geographic researches in Fassa, making important discoveries (he found some manuscripts and even the medioeval regulation written at the beginning of the XIX Century by the notary Mr. Dovolavilla). Also after having left the valley, he would continue to study it and in the SAT 1883 yearbook, he baptized the highest peak of the Dolomites (3442 metres) as “the Queen”.
