HIGHLIGHT

"THE DEVIL TITA PIAZ" BY THE MUSEUM

Remembered as the "Devil of the Dolomites", he passed away in Pera at 71 (for a trivial incident by bike), in his hometown. Giovanni Battista Piazz, known as "Tita" has been one of the most important alpinists between the end of the Nineteenth century and the beginning of the Twentieth. The tonight appointment "Chel Diaol de Pavarin" that takes place at 5.30 p.m. at the Ladin Museum with the historian Cesare Bernard is dedicated to him. Piazz entered the history of alpinism in 1898 when, still in his teens, he climbed alone the Winkler Tower. This gave him worldwide fame, confirmed by the infinite number of climbing tracks open in the Dolomites and around the Alps. He was imprisoned for his political choices, then major of Pera, writer, and he even helped opening some refuges in Fassa. An intricate and charming character that will be analysed during the today appointment, followed by an aperitif.

Itineraries

FROM THE REFUGE PAOLINA TO THE REFUGE RODA DI VAEI

Reach the Karerpass from Vigo (1746 m) and then go on toward the namesake lake, until when you see a label indicating the chairlift Paolina on your right (with the car park beside). Take the chair lift that, in few minutes, leads to Rifugio Paolina at 2125 metres. Take path number 539 that goes up on wide steps and allows to admire the powerful rocks of the group of Catinaccio on one side and of the Latemar on the other. After an uphill stretch, go on along a pleasant plain, sometimes rocky, until (after about 30 minutes) you come across a big bronze eagle of which you can't avoid taking a picture. It is the monument dedicated to Theodor Christomannos, to whom is due the construction of the "Great Road of the Dolomites". After about 30 minutes walking, along the path n. 549, you will reach the refuge Roda di Vael. Go back along the same path.

Did you know that...

There's a legend that connects the feast of Our Lady of the Snow to the glacier of the Marmolada: on August, 5 the inhabitants of Fassa should withdraw from working at altitude to honour the religious feast. It is believed that an avid woman, a peasant, once didn't leave the highest fields because a storm was approaching, the grass would have got ruined and she would have lost the hay harvest. So, at night in August, a big amount of snow fell and layered, so much to create the glacier of the Marmolada. The ice reached even the hut of the old woman, making her lose the harvest and transforming her in an iced statue.
