WALTER NIEDERMAYR'S HIGH HORIZONS

Walter Niedermayr, who has been professor of Art photography at the University of Bolzano for long and who is also a great interpreter of the Alpine landscape. Walter Niedermayr is the today protagonist of the second appointment, taking place at 9 p.m. by the PalaDolomites in Campestrin, of the festival "Orizzonti Alti", dedicated to some contemporary protagonist of the photography. Niedermayr, born in Bolzano in 1952, started his photography research in 1985 and, since that time, he is attentive to the perception of the atmosphere of open spaces. The alpine areas, as well as the urban infrastructures, the architectural and industrial works are the subject of the efficient resource of the photographer, also through the composite pictures. In particular, his pictures show the consequences produced by the increasing of mass tourism in the alpine landscape.

Itineraries

FROM POZZA TO THE MEADOWS OF CIANCOAL TO MEIDA

Get to the bridge on Avisio River, which links Pozza with Meida and walk along the sidewalk that skirts the state road toward Pera. After 200 metres, leave it, always following now Avisio's flow. Continue until the wooden bridge of Piciocaa. Once you have crossed it, you will arrive in front of a chapel recently restored and a large playground for children. Make your way to the lower path towards Meida, and cross a broad grassy plain in Ciancoal. When you arrive at the asphalt road bearing the same name, you begin to ascend. Afterwards turn right in the Street del Piz and enter Meida, where you find the Church of San Nicolò. From here, follow Street de Meida, and you will get back to the departure point.

Did you know that...

In the past centuries, fires were a frequent danger in Val di Fassa. Houses and haylofts, mostly made of wood, were often victim of the flames, also because of the open fireplaces of the kitchens. A simple distraction was enough, in fact, to cause fires that would involve the whole village. For this reason the figure of the "soprastante" was instituted: a sort of firefighter that would take care of the maintenance of the stoves, of the fireplaces and of the chimneys of the houses in the village.
